Downtown and Southern Helsinki

Agricola Church Crypt, Tehtaankatu 23

Vartiokylä Church, Kiviportintie 5



The Common Responsibility Campaign

is a nationwide social movement based on the philosophy “love thy neighbour” and the annual fundraising campaign of the Finnish Lutheran Church. The Campaign defends neglected people and advocates for caring and justice.

50 % of the proceeds of the Campaign are channeled to the Finn Church Aid’s Disaster Fund, 20 % is used annually for financial aid for variable charity projects in Finland and 30 % for diaconal work carried out by the local parishes.
